INTERVIEWS GUIDELINES

- 1. Candidates will receive a calendar with a schedule of their interviews and indication whether it will be on-site or on-line (Zoom platform).
- 2. Interviews consist in a discussion of the candidate's research project, the underlying physics and the broader scientific context.
- 3. Each interview will last around 15 mins, including questions.
- 4. Candidates are strongly encouraged to present their project in english, although italian is also accepted.
- 5. PC slides and presentations are not allowed.
- 6. During the interview the candidate can make use of a support to write and draw (blackboard).
- 7. If on-line this may be achieved using, e.g.:
 - a) a tablet/touchPC shared through the Zoom session;
 - a piece of paper visualized by an external device having a camera (e.g. a phone), shared through a second Zoom session;
 - c) a physical black/white-board framed by the PC camera or by an external one.
- 8. During the interview (both in presence and online) each candidate has to show a valid ID document with a photograph.

NOTE FOR ON-LINE CANDIDATES: Whatever kind of connection you prefer, test it in advance! And when you're done, test it again! There will not be time to fix any technical problem at the time of the interview.
